Appeal for Mulanje Mission Hospital



<u>Mulanje Mission Hospital</u> serves a population of 550,000 people in the Mulanje district of south east Malawi. The hospital is braced for COVID- 19 and launched an appeal in March. Malawi is just now beginning to see their first deaths from COVID- 19.

"In Malawi, hospitals are less well prepared for a pandemic like this. Understaffed, weak public health care facilities, poor availability of personal protective equipment and testkits and very few intensive care

options are a daily reality. With the disruption of global supply chains, access to drugs and medical supplies becomes increasingly difficult and expensive. Mulanje Mission Hospital with its reputation of good clinical care will likely see an influx of COVID-19 and other cases from the whole surrounding area. We are getting prepared to help those who seek our care, but require additional funds to do so effectively. Please consider a donation to help us making maximum impact during this difficult time.

There is a lot we can do. Health education to patients and communities; provision of infection prevention supplies such as soap and disinfectant, provision of protective equipment for health care workers and patients and strict adherence to infection prevention measures. For very sick patients extra oxygen concentrators and other intensive treatments are required and can make the difference between life and death.

As all around the world work together to control this crisis, please also stand with the people of Malawi and Mulanje and consider a donation, no matter how small."

£40 could fund 2 infrared thermometers.


£1800 could provide one oxygen concentrating machine that will work on our solar system.

The MMH Sustainable Livelihoods programme supports a number of activities which reduce carbon emissions. Face coverings


Face Coverings **handmade** by Sally Evans from chitenje materials bought by Alison Campbell when the group was visiting Mulanje! All proceeds go to Mulanje Mission Hospital! Suggested Donation £5.00

- 2 designs: orange/green/black swirl or blue/green flowers (the design on each one may vary due to the pattern)
- 4 layers: outer chitenje fabric plus two fine layers of cotton and one of polyester.
- Expandable pleats and soft elastic cord hoops, with toggles allowing adjustment for a comfortable fit over the ears.
- Channel for a nose wire, which should be removed before washing. 2 nose wires included.
- Designed to be worn bridged on the nose and just under the chin (18-19 cm wide and expands to 15cms deep).
- Includes a small pouch made from rip-stop fabric as illustrated.
- These are non-medical face coverings.



Other patterns and plain coloured face coverings can be made to order (see right hand photo). These will be made with 3 layers of fabric, without toggles and with or without the channel for removable nose wires. Other sizes also available. Please email for further details.
