Job 19: 1-11; 21-27

Then Job answered:

- ² "How long will you torment me and break me in pieces with words?
- ³ These ten times you have cast reproach upon me; are you not ashamed to wrong me?
- ⁴ And even if it is true that I have erred, my error remains with me.
- ⁵ If indeed you magnify yourselves against me and make my humiliation an argument against me,
- ⁶ know then that God has put me in the wrong and closed his net around me.
- ⁷ Even when I cry out, 'Violence!' I am not answered; I call aloud, but there is no justice.
- ⁸ He has walled up my way so that I cannot pass, and he has set darkness upon my paths.
- 9 He has stripped my glory from me and taken the crown from my head.
- ¹⁰ He breaks me down on every side, and I am gone; he has uprooted my hope like a tree.
- ¹¹ He has kindled his wrath against me and counts me as his adversary.
- ²¹ Have pity on me, have pity on me, O you my friends, for the hand of God has touched me!

²⁷ whom I shall see on my side, and my eyes shall behold, and not another. My heart faints within me!

³⁸ Then two rebels were crucified with him, one on his right and one on his left. ³⁹ Those who passed by derided him, shaking their heads ⁴⁰ and saying, "You who would destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! If you are the Son of God, come down from the cross." ⁴¹ In the same way the chief priests also, along with the scribes and elders, were mocking him, saying, ⁴² "He saved others; he cannot save himself. He is the King of Israel; let him come down from the cross now, and we will believe in him. ⁴³ He trusts in God; let God deliver him now, if he wants to, for he said, 'I am God's Son." ⁴⁴ The rebels who were crucified with him also taunted him in the same way.

⁴⁵ From noon on, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon. ⁴⁶ And about three o'clock Jesus cried with a loud voice, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"
